

E. Sharing with large group: In turn, each of the spokespersons briefly summarizes the prospects and leads identified by their small group (30 minutes).

F. Thanks and optional closing prayer: *The Lord's Prayer*

G. Parish bulletin: A summary of the main ideas generated by the workshop could be published in the parish bulletin.

Another Possibility: Why not review the fundamentals of our Faith — accompanied by a competent person — during a series of meetings organized with a view to studying together, one by one, the articles of the CREED? Guided reading and meditation of Part One of the Catechism of the Catholic Church (*The Profession of Faith*) will help us on the path of conversion.
