Biography: Alethea Peca is a P.h.d candidate in bioethics at the Athenaeum Pontificium Regina Apostolorum in Rome, Italy. She earned her Licentiate in Bioethics, from the Athenaeum Pontificium Regina Apostolorum in 2011 and her Masters Diploma in Bioethics in 2009. Over the past four years she has spoken at various workshops and conferences in the Calgary area on beginning and end of life issues, technology, and bioethics and Catholic teaching.
