The Road to Discipleship: Just the Carpenter's Son

Jesus' own hometown friends were critical of him. They refused to believe anything more of him than they already knew. They assumed they knew him and put him in a category with no room for change or growth. Unsurprisingly, Jesus could work no deeds of power due to their unbelief. When people band together in dislike of someone, growth and freedom stop. Call it bullying, discrimination, and even genocide.
