We are sending you this message because you subscribe to the print edition of the Western Catholic Reporter.

As you are likely aware, Canada Post and the Canadian Union of Postal Workers are embroiled in a labour dispute which may lead soon to a lockout or strike. The Western Catholic Reporter, which depends on Canada Post for delivery, has therefore decided not to publish our regular print edition dated July 11 or any other print edition for the duration of the lockout or strike.

As well, the WCR will extend the subscriptions of paid subscribers by the number of issues not published during the labour dispute.
