

Archdiocesan Committees – Appendix 103A

Administrators of church goods are entrusted as stewards with the goods of the Church and carry out their mission with the aid, advice and sometimes the consent of members of various committees designed for these purposes.

Archdiocesan Finance Council

The Archdiocesan Finance Council is established in accordance with *The Code of Canon Law* (Can. 492 and 493) to “be composed of at least three of the faithful, experts in financial affairs and civil law, of outstanding integrity, and appointed by the Archbishop.”

The Council is presided over by the Archbishop in the financial matters of the Archdiocese. The present members are: the Archbishop, the Vicar General, the Moderator of the Curia, a parish priest, four lay faithful people, and the Financial Administrator.

The Council members are appointed for a period of five years and may be reappointed for further terms.

Project Review Committee

The archdiocesan Project Review Committee is appointed by the Archbishop to advise him on matters relating to construction or renovations. The Project Review Committee ensures that there is adherence to the archdiocesan Guidelines for Construction and Major Renovations.

The Project Review Committee is composed of at least three of the faithful, experts in construction and related financial matters. Present members are: the Moderator of the Curia, four lay faithful, and the Financial Administrator. The Committee members are appointed for a period of five years and may be reappointed for further terms.
