Protocols in the Sudden Absence of the Pastor

Policy Statement:	Parishes must develop protocols in case the pastor cannot celebrate the Sunday Eucharist.
Intent of Policy:	To provide for the Sunday Celebration of the Eucharist or a Sunday Celebration of the Word in the sudden absence of the pastor.
Procedure: Refer to Policy:	The following protocols are to be established in the parish:
	• Designate a person(s) in the parish as the contact responsible for communicating the situation to the Dean and the Office of the Chancellor, and coordinating the necessary actions in the parish.
	• Have emergency contact information of the Dean and the Chancellor accessible (see Appendix 232A Emergency Contact Information Template).
	• Permanent deacons are trained and ready to use the ritual for <i>Sunday Celebration of the Word and Hours</i> .
	• If the parish does not have a permanent deacon, lay ministers will be trained to preside at a Sunday Celebration of the Word.
	In the sudden absence of the pastor:
	• Immediately communicate the situation involving the pastor to the Dean and to the Chancellor.
	• Determine with the assistance of the Dean and/or Chancellor whether a priest is available to celebrate the Sunday Eucharist.
	• If no priest is available to celebrate the Sunday Eucharist, implement Policy No. 511 Sunday Celebration of the Word.
