Parish Blueprints Policy No. 206

**Policy Statement:** Upon completion of new construction, or major renovation, the

Archdiocese requires that a copy of all 'as built' drawings for buildings be submitted for storage to the Office of the Financial

Administrator.

Intent of the policy: The buildings are important assets to the Archdiocese and the central

storage of a copy of all blueprints offers an additional measure of protection. After any damage by fire, partial or full destruction of buildings, the plans, drawings and/or blueprints of the church buildings, rectories, etc. that have been affected, must be supplied to the insurance adjuster to enable a proper assessment of damage. The plans are usually referred to an architect to assure both the insured and the insurer that replacement is made of like material and design.
