Retirement Policy No. 419

Priests are eligible for retirement at the age of 75 years. Policy Statement:

Definition: A retired priest is one who no longer holds an office and has received

the written permission of the Archbishop to retire.

Procedure:

Priests are to offer their resignation from office in writing to the Archbishop during their 75th year and prior to their 75th birthday.

Illness, infirmity or some other circumstance may require a priest to **Exceptions:**

request retirement before his 75th birthday.
