

Retirement

Policy No. 419

- Policy Statement:*** Priests are eligible for retirement at the age of 75 years.
- Definition:*** A retired priest is one who no longer holds an office and has received the written permission of the Archbishop to retire.
- Procedure:*** Priests are to offer their resignation from office in writing to the Archbishop during their 75th year and prior to their 75th birthday.
- Exceptions:*** Illness, infirmity or some other circumstance may require a priest to request retirement before his 75th birthday.
