## **Responsibility of Parents**

## Policy No. 600

Policy Statement:	Parents are responsible for requesting the Sacrament of Baptism for their infant or child.
Definition:	<b>Parents</b> are the birth mother and birth father or the adoptive mother and the adoptive father.
	Adoptive parents must have received final papers from the Provincial Court of Judgment.
	NB. A letter from the adoption agency granting legal rights, including Baptism is not sufficient, as these are not the final legal papers.
	A Court appointed guardian is an adult appointed by the Provincial Court who is responsible for the care of a child and has the right to make decisions concerning that child.
Procedure:	a) Parents are to formally request Baptism at their proper parish.
	b) Ideally this request should be made so that Baptism can take place as soon as possible after birth of the child.
	c) Complete the Baptism of a Child Form – Appendix 603A.
	d) Select sponsor(s).
	e) Complete a Baptism Preparation program.
