Policy Statement:	Along with an initiated Catholic Sponsor, a validly baptized non- Catholic person can be a Witness to the Baptism.	
Intent of Policy	To indicate that there is a degree of unity among Christians through Baptism.	
Procedure:	a)	A person baptized in the Catholic Church who has not completed the Sacraments of Initiation (Confirmation & Eucharist) may be a Witness, not a Sponsor. It is not recommended to designate a baptized Catholic as a Witness. Baptized Catholics should be encouraged to complete their Sacraments of Initiation.
	b)	The Christian Baptism of the non-Catholic person selected to be a Witness must be verified. (See Appendix 612C Validity of Baptism in the Catholic Church).
	c)	The Witness must be of opposite sex to the Sponsor.
	d)	The name of the Christian Witness may be indicated on the Baptism Certificate as '(Christian Witness)'.
