Burial Register Entries

Policy No. 821

Policy Statement: Complete information for each death, funeral service and burial is to

be legibly entered in the hard bound Burial Register.

Definitions: Funeral Mass is a Mass in the presence of the body or cremated

remains, a short time after death.

Memorial Mass is a Mass celebrated some-time after the burial has

taken place.

Graveside Service is a prayer service at the gravesite at the time of

interment of the remains or cremated remains.

Burial/Interment is placing a remains or cremated remains in a

cemetery grounds or columbarium.

Procedure: Entries in the Burial Register must be <u>clearly printed</u> using a

permanent black ink pen.

The information required as the columns generally appear (there may

be some variation) in the hard bound Burial Register:

Information required for each column:

Column 1 NO. (Number)

• List the entries chronologically: No. / Year ▶ 1/2010, 2/2010, 3/2010 ...

Column 2 Name

- Name of the person exactly as it appears on the Certificate of Death
- Surname must be underlined Clarence <u>Jones</u>

Column 3 Date of Death

Date of death as it appears on Certificate of Death
21 January 2009

Column 4 Age

• Indicate age of the deceased > 93

Column 5 Name of Witness (Spouse, Siblings, Children ...)

- Name of spouse, siblings, children witnessing the funeral > Jill Jones (spouse), Frank Jones (son).
- One or two names are sufficient as witnesses.



Column 6 Clergy

 Print the name of the clergy officiating. In most Burial Registers, there is a space provided for the signature of the clergy. However the clergy is not required to sign the burial record.

Column 7 Sacrament

Date and reception of the "Sacrament of the Sick"
20 January 2009 Sacrament of the Sick

Column 8 Re-title Funeral Service Burial Date Funeral Service

Date and place of Funeral Mass/Graveside Service
 27 January 2009, St. Agnes, Edmonton (Funeral Mass)

Column 9 Burial Date and Place

Date and place of Burial (Name & Location)
 27 January 2009, St. Anthony Cemetery, Edmonton
 If the name and location of the cemetery or columbarium – for cremated remains – are unknown at the time of recording the burial/death, write "burial at a later date."

Column 10 Additional Information

- Funeral Home
 - ▶ Connelly-McKinley Ltd., Edmonton
- Any information after a deceased person has been buried and who is may have been a parishioner could be recorded in this column.
