## **Profession of Faith Certificate**

## Policy No. 826

Policy Statement:	A Profession of Faith certificate is to be issued as soon as possible after the Sacraments of Initiation have been celebrated or as requested at a later date.
Definitions:	The Profession of Faith certificate reflects the canonical status of a person received into the Catholic Church. It is an exact duplicate of a Profession of Faith entry in the Baptism Register.
Procedure:	<ul> <li>a) Certificates can be purchased, a parish may computer generate their own certificate (providing it contains all the required information), or the archdiocesan certificate template may be used.</li> <li>Appendix 826A – Profession of Faith (Adult) Certificate Template</li> <li>Appendix 826B – Profession of Faith (Child) Certificate Template</li> <li>b) A Profession of Faith certificate contains the following: <ul> <li>name of the one received into the Catholic Church</li> <li>Name of parents (maiden name of mother)</li> <li>date and place of birth (dd/mmm/yy)</li> <li>name of church &amp; denomination of original Baptism</li> <li>date and place of original Baptism (dd/mmm/yy)</li> <li>name of Catholic church</li> <li>name of clergy who received the person into the Church</li> <li>name of sponsor(s)</li> <li>notations on reverse side, as necessary.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	c) Date and seal the certificate.
	d) The pastor or his delegate must sign the certificate (c.535 §3).
	e) Print/type the name of the pastor below the signature.
