Appointments	Policy No. PD401
Policy Statement:	The Archbishop appoints each permanent deacon to a parish or to another pastoral assignment according to the needs of the Archdiocese.
Procedure:	a) Appointments will be made in consultation with the Office of the Permanent Diaconate, the Vicar for Clergy and the Pastor of the parish as required.
	 b) Individual appointments will be reviewed on an annual basis by the Office of the Permanent Diaconate in consultation with the Vicar for Clergy.
	c) In the assignment process, significant consideration will be given to the permanent deacon's wife, family, employment, and personal circumstances.
	d) Pastors or supervisors cannot remove a permanent deacon from a canonical assignment nor may permanent deacons remove themselves from a canonical assignment.
	e) Permanent deacons may not move from their parish or other pastoral assignment without reassignment by the Archbishop.
