DAY 0 - SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 18, 2022 - DEPARTURE EDMONTON AT 12 NOON

DAY 1 - MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, 2022 - VENICE - ITALY


DAY 8 - MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 26, 2022 – ASSISI AND ROME
