Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In the Book of Genesis, Abram questions God's promise that he, Abram, will be the Father of Many Nations ("Abraham"). To strengthen Abram's faith, God takes him outside and says:

"Look toward heaven and count the stars, if you are able to count them." Then He said to him, "So shall your descendants be." Genesis 15:5

We are then told that Abram believed the Lord, and it was reckoned to him as righteousness. While I don't presume to compare myself to Father Abraham, I can understand how he feels.
