## Launching Your Parish Plan: The 4Ws

#### **WHO**

- Identify who should be at the launch.
- Also determine your target number of attendees.

#### **WHAT**

Identify what type of launch it will be.

#### WHERE

 Determine where you want your launch to be.

#### **WHEN**

- Launch dates for the entire diocese are September 14 and 15.
- Identify the exact date and time when you'd like to have this launch.

- Prayers of the Faithful
- Post the pastoral priorities on parish website
- Archbishop's video message

Mass-goers	Mass and Pancake Breakfast	Church and Assembly Hall	Regular Mass times – September 14 and 15 Pancake Breakfast after 10am Mass of September 15

- Postcards to be distributed to parishioners
- Prayers of the Faithful
- Powerpoint template to present the parish plan during the Pancake Breakfast
