

Her parents were the late Joseph (Shuzah) and Flora Potts. Her grandparents were James Courteoreille (Joseph Potts), Annie Akanas, George Aginas, Zetta Kootenay. Her great grandparents were Adolphus L'Hirondelle, Margaret Courteoreille, Benjamin Akanas, Mary Louise Kootenay, Joseph and Amelia Lefthand. May they rest in peace.

Gina is a mother to 4 children and a grandmother of 8. She has several God children and customarily adopted children and grandchildren. Gina was born and raised a Catholic, receiving a catholic education, her sacraments and attending church with her Ina (Mother). Her father would often read scriptures and the gospel.

Every since she could walk, she walk barefoot to pilgrimage to the Holy Lands of Lac Ste Anne, and other pilgrimages to Marian sites in Medjugorje and Venezuela. Gina coordinated the Lac Ste Anne pilgrimage for a few years, volunteered to prepare meals for the priests and liturgical team at Lac Ste Anne, and most recently assisted in the preliminary planning of the Papal visit to Lac Ste Anne.
