

- 2. Reception of the Eucharist: Participate in the Holy Mass and receive Communion.
- 3. Prayers for the Holy Father's Intentions: Offer prayers for the Pope, which can include an Our Father, Hail Mary, or prayers of your choice.
- 4. Detachment from Sin: Foster a sincere heart and true contrition, with no attachment to even venial sin.

By fulfilling these conditions, pilgrims can gain the full spiritual benefit of the plenary indulgence. This indulgence can also be offered for the souls of the faithful departed, helping them on their journey to heaven.

DAY 1: Feb. 18, 2025 DEPARTURE FROM CANADA Day 2: Feb 19, 2025 - Arrival in Rome

Arrive in Rome and check into your accommodation. Group welcome dinner, orientation, and spiritual reflection to begin the pilgrimage journey.

Day 3: Feb 20, 2025 - Key Churches for Deacons in Rome

- Visit the Scala Santa (Holy Stairs), an important pilgrimage site representing Jesus' Passion.
- Basilica of St. John Lateran, the cathedral of Rome and the seat of the Pope's authority.
- Visit the Basilica of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem (Santa Croce in Gerusalemme), housing relics from the Passion of Christ, including fragments of the True Cross.
- Church of St. Lawrence Outside the Walls, one of the most important churches dedicated to a deacon saint, St. Lawrence, with reflections on martyrdom and service.
- Evening: Group dinner and reflection session.

Day 4 - 6: Feb 21-23, 2025 - Main Deacons' Jubilee Events (No Tours Scheduled)

- Attend the official Deacons' Jubilee events in Rome, including Masses, teachings, and group reflections organized by the Vatican.
- Included: breakfasts and dinners at the hotel and transfers from hotel to Vatican
- Not Included in the price: Solidarity fee of €20 to attend the Deacon's Jubilee events from Feb 21-23.

Pilgrims who do not want to attend the Deacon's event during these days will have these days as free time to explore Rome and nearby areas on their own.

Day 7: Feb 24, 2025 - The Legacy of St. Paul

- Visit St. Paul Outside the Walls, a major basilica and the burial place of St.
- Visit Tre Fontane Abbey, where St. Paul was martyred, reflecting on his powerful missionary journey.

Day 8: Feb 25, 2025 - Pilgrimage to Assisi (Day 1)

- Travel to Assisi, the hometown of St. Francis.
- Visit the Basilica of St. Francis, where St. Francis is entombed, and the Basilica of St. Clare, which houses the body of St. Clare.
- Evening: Group reflection and overnight stay in Assisi.

Day 9: Feb 26, 2025 - Pilgrimage to Assisi (Day 2)

- Morning: Visit Santa Maria degli Angeli and the Porziuncola, a special place in Franciscan spirituality, where St. Francis heard his calling.
- Afternoon: Visit the Sanctuary of the Spoliation, where Blessed Carlo Acutis is laid to rest, emphasizing modern Catholic spirituality.
- Evening: Return to Rome for a peaceful evening and optional reflection.

Day 10: Feb 27, 2025 - Marian Devotion and Apostolic Churches

- Visit the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the largest Marian churches in the world, for a spiritual reflection on Mary's role in the Church.
- Visit the Church of St. Alphonsus Liguori, home to the icon of Our Lady of Perpetual Help.
- Free time in the afternoon
- Group farewell dinner and final reflections on the pilgrimage journey.

Day 11: Feb 28, 2025 - Final Reflections and Departure

After breakfast, head to the airport to board your flight home.
