DAY 2 MON MAY 19




The group arrives at Dublin Airport (DUB). They are warmly greeted by their tour manager, who will accompany them throughout the entire journey. Transfer to the hotel and the remainder of the day is at leisure for you to get settled.

Gather together this evening for a Welcome dinner at the hotel. Overnight in Dublin.




After a well rested sleep, join your tour manager to embark on a panoramic tour of Dublin, Ireland's vibrant capital. The tour includes a visit to **Christ Church Cathedral**, a stunning medieval church dating back to the 11th century, known for its impressive architecture and rich history as both a cathedral and a center of Irish religious life. The group will also explore **Trinity College**, Ireland's oldest university, home to the famous Book of Kells, a beautifully illuminated manuscript dating back to the 9th century that is one of the country's greatest treasures.

The tour concludes with **Mass at Whitefriar Street Carmelite Church**, where the group can reflect in this peaceful and historic setting, before returning to the hotel. The rest of the day can be enjoyed at leisure. Overnight in Dublin.

Hotel: Hotel Riu Plaza The Gresham

The day begins with a morning Mass, followed by a visit to the Legion of Mary, an organization deeply rooted in Ireland's Catholic history, dedicated to the spiritual and charitable work of the Church.


In the afternoon, the group heads to **Kilmainham Gaol**, a former prison that played a pivotal role in Ireland's struggle for independence. Here, visitors can walk through the hauntingly preserved cells and corridors, where many prominent Irish political figures were once incarcerated.

The next stop is the **Guinness Storehouse**, where the world-famous stout is brewed. This interactive experience explores the history of the Guinness brand and its brewing process, with a chance to enjoy a pint at the Gravity Bar, offering panoramic views of the Dublin skyline. Afterward, the group will enjoy dinner at a local Dublin restaurant and overnight in the city.

This morning, enjoy a visit to **St. Patrick's Cathedral**, an iconic symbol of Dublin and one of the most magnificent Gothic structures in Ireland. The cathedral is also home to the story of Jonathan Swift, author of Gulliver's Travels, who served as its dean.


From here, the group heads south to Glendalough, a breathtaking valley in County Wicklow that was the site of an ancient monastic settlement founded by St. Kevin in the 6th century. You will attend **Mass at St. Kevin's Church**, nestled in the heart of this tranquil landscape.

Afterward, you will explore the **Glendalough Monastic Site**, where visitors can wander among ancient ruins, including a round tower, several churches, and St. Kevin's Cell, before visiting the Visitor Centre to learn more about the site's rich history.

In the evening, the group travels to Kilkenny to visit **Kilkenny Castle**, a magnificent Norman castle dating back to the 12th century. The castle is known for its stunning gardens and impressive interiors, which showcase Ireland's aristocratic history. The group will check into their hotel and stay overnight in Kilkenny.

Today, head out for a guided tour of the **Rock of Cashel**, an awe-inspiring complex of medieval ruins perched on a limestone hill. The site includes a cathedral, round tower, and Cormac's Chapel, and offers spectacular views of the surrounding countryside.

Afterward, the group heads to **Cobh**, a picturesque town with a strong maritime heritage. You will attend **Mass at St. Colman's Cathedral**, a striking Gothic cathedral with a soaring spire that overlooks the harbor. After Mass, the group will visit the Cobh Heritage Centre, where they will learn about the town's role as a major departure point for Irish emigrants, as well as its connection to the Titanic disaster.

The group will then travel to Blarney, home to the world-famous **Blarney Castle**. Here, they can climb to the top of the castle to kiss the legendary Blarney Stone, said to grant the gift of eloquence. The group will also have free time to visit Blarney Woollen Mills, a large store offering a wide range of Irish-made woolen goods and souvenirs.

In the evening, the group will travel to Killarney to check into the hotel.




The day begins with morning Mass, followed by a spectacular day exploring the **Ring of Kerry**, one of Ireland's most scenic drives. The Ring takes visitors through lush green landscapes, charming villages, and along the rugged coastline, with several key stops, including the colorful town of Sneem, known for its brightly painted houses, and Molls Gap, which offers stunning views of the surrounding mountains. A highlight of the day is a traditional jaunting car tour, a horse-drawn carriage ride through the scenic Killarney National Park to Ross Castle, a 15th-century fortress located on the edge of Lough Leane. Afterward, the group will return to Killarney for dinner at a local restaurant and overnight in the town.

Hotel: The International Hotel Killarney

Meals Included: Breakfast, Dinner





The group starts the day with Mass in Killarney, before traveling to Galway on the western coast of Ireland. En route, stop at the Cliffs of Moher, one of Ireland's most iconic natural wonders, offering dramatic views of the Atlantic Ocean from towering cliffs that rise 700 feet above the sea. The journey continues through the Burren, a unique and barren limestone landscape that is home to rare plants and ancient archaeological sites. Upon arrival in Galway, the group will enjoy a panormaic tour of this lively city, famous for its arts scene, colorful streets, and vibrant atmosphere. If time allows, you may visit Galway Cathedral, one of the most impressive modern cathedrals in Ireland, and will provide a moment of quiet reflection. Afterward, the group will travel through the scenic Connemara region, known for its rugged beauty and expansive lakes, before reaching Knock. Dinner will be included this evening, and the group will stay overnight in Knock.

Hotel: Knock House Hotel (two nights) Meals Included: Breakfast, Dinner



Today will be a spiritually enriching full-day experience at Knock Shrine. The day begins with morning Mass at the Apparition Chapel, followed by a guided walking tour of the Knock Shrine Grounds, offering a deeper connection to the history and significance of this pilgrimage destination. Afterward, the group will enjoy a guided tour of the Knock Museum, which provides further insights into the shrine's rich history. At 2:00 pm, pilgrims will gather for the **Stations of the Cross and the Rosary**, with the prayers being broadcast across the grounds and into the churches, creating a powerful atmosphere of communal devotion.

At 3:00 pm, the highlight of the day will be the **Mass at Knock Basilica**, which will include the **Blessing of the Sick ceremony**, an opportunity for participants to seek spiritual healing and blessings. For those seeking reconciliation, Confessions will be offered from 10:30 am to 4:00 pm at the Chapel of Reconciliation. Throughout the day, the Blessed Sacrament Chapel will also be open for Adoration, offering a quiet space for prayer and reflection. This day at Knock Shrine will be a meaningful experience of faith, reflection, and renewal.

Hotel: <u>Knock House Hotel</u> Meals Included: Breakfast

This morning, enjoy Mass at the Knock Shrine, one of the most important Marian pilgrimage sites in Ireland, where an apparition of the Virgin Mary, St. Joseph, and St. John the Evangelist was reported in 1879.

The group then departs for Belfast, the capital of Northern Ireland, where they will visit the **Titanic Belfast Museum**. This state-of-the-art museum chronicles the story of the Titanic, from its construction in the city's shipyards to its tragic sinking. The group will then check into your hotel and stay overnight in Belfast.

DAY 11 WED MAY 28





After checking out in the morning, transfer to the ferry port for a scenic crossing from to Cairnryan in Scotland, an essential part of the journey that offers a unique opportunity to experience the beauty of the Irish Sea. The ferry route is renowned for its stunning views, as it glides across the water between two beautiful coastal regions.

Upon arrival, the group will travel to Glasgow, Scotland's largest city, where you will enjoy an orientation tour to see its highlights, including the grand architecture of George Square and the renowned Kelvingrove Art Gallery and Museum. The group will attend Mass at St. Andrew's Cathedral, a beautiful example of Gothic Revival architecture. Afterward, enjoy an included lunch at a local restaurant. From there the group will continue to Edinburgh, Scotland's capital, where they will take a tour along the Royal Mile, a historic street that stretches from Edinburgh Castle to the Palace of Holyroodhouse.


Hotel: <u>Yotel Edinburgh</u> (three nights) Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch



Your first morning in Scotland begins with Mass, followed by a visit to Stirling Castle, one of Scotland's most important and historically rich castles, associated with figures like William Wallace and Mary, Queen of Scots. After a guided tour of the castle, the group will have some free time to explore the cobbled streets of Stirling.

In the afternoon, the group will return to Edinburgh for a unique **whisky** tasting experience, where they will sample up to four different Scotch whiskies, learning about the history and process of whisky-making in Scotland. The group will overnight in Edinburgh.

Hotel: Yotel Edinburgh Meals Included: Breakfast



Today starts with Mass and a visit to the Shrine of Venerable Margaret Sinclair, a Catholic laywoman from Edinburgh who is a candidate for beatification.

In the afternoon, the group will visit the **Palace of Holyroodhouse**, the official residence of the British monarch in Scotland, with its elegant architecture and beautiful gardens. The group will also explore Edinburgh Castle, a historic fortress that dominates the skyline of the city, housing the Crown Jewels of Scotland and offering panoramic views of the surrounding area.

A farewell dinner at a local restaurant will conclude the day, and the group will stay overnight in Edinburgh.
